CU reopens but no classes held

CHITTAGONG, Apr 1: No classes were held at the Chittagong University when it reopened today after three and a half months of closure, reports UNB.

The university was closed for an indefinite period following a bloody clash between ruling party backed BCL and Shibir on December 19 that left two Shibir activists killed.

Two university shuttle trains with 20 students left the railway station for the campus this morning but none of the 22 busses between CU and the city operated.

Syndicate held an emergency meeting today with VC Abdul Mannan in the chair. It urged the students and guardians to help restore a congenial academic atmosphere.

Meanwhile, Chhatra Oikya, a combine of JCD and Shibir, continued its siege and strike on the campus opposing reopening of the university without meeting its demands including removal of the VC and Pro-VC.

Chhatra Oikya and BCL held separate rallies on the campus
