

MEDICAL COLLEGE ADMISSION QUESTION

Involve fewer people to prevent leaks

Meeting told

The number of people and phases involved in the process of producing medical college admission question paper and its delivery to examination halls should be brought down to prevent leaks, a meeting was told yesterday.

There should also be an independent committee to conduct the admission test, the speakers suggested. Doctors and professors of medical colleges and universities gave the recommendations at the meeting organised by Doctors for Health and Environment at Dhaka's Jatiya Press Club.

"Some people are doing business by leaking questions," said Prof Anu Muhammad of Jahangirnagar University. "Coaching centres and government officials are involved in this."

Prof Tanzimuddin Khan of Dhaka University said the admission test result processing system had to be more transparent. Dr MA Rashid, a director at DGHS, said the government had already formed a committee to observe this year's admission test to ensure transparency.
