

## PSC recommends 898 for primary head posts

Bangladesh Public Service Commission (BPSC) yesterday recommended appointing as government primary school headmasters 898 candidates who passed the 34th Bangladesh Civil Service (BCS) examination.

The non-cadre second-class positions were suggested due to a shortage of vacancies in cadre and non-cadre first-class ones, says a BPSC press release.

This is the highest collective number of candidates being recommended for non-cadre posts.

"The government will give the final appointment after the candidates are declared eligible in the medical board health test and the pre-appointment verification by proper agencies," said the release.

Of 6,584 candidates passing the exam, 2,159 were recommended for different cadres.

BPSC is appointing them under the Non-cadre Posts Recruitment (Special) Rules-2010 and its amended rules issued on June 16, 2014.
