

Administrative activities at JU disrupted

Academic and administrative activities of Jahangirnagar University (JU) were disrupted for the second consecutive day yesterday as Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) and Students' Unity for Resistance to Rapists (SURR) kept the offices at the Administrative Building under lock and key to press their demands including resignation of the Vice Chancellor.

Both the student organisations also threatened that they would continue their programme until the VC resigns.

No officials and employees could attend the offices as activists of both the organisations prevented them at the gates of the Administrative Building.

Earlier, the SURR activists locked all offices at 7.00 am.

Also, no classes were held because of SURR-enforced indefinite strike which stretched into 44th day yesterday.

Meanwhile, JCD has announced that they would resist the syndicate meeting scheduled for Saturday at all costs.

At a rally yesterday, the JCD leaders said that no meeting of university bodies would be held before the resignation of VC Prof. Abdul Bayes.

They said the present administration has failed to run the university properly and accused the high level officials of abusing power and patronising rapists and killers.
