BCS Gen Edn Assoc executives

A 79-member executive committee of the BCS Sadharan Shikha Samity (BCS General Education Association) has been elected with Prof Jahanara Begum and Prof Mohammad Kaif Uddin as its president and general secretary respectively.

Former DG of the Directorate of Secondary and Higher Education Prof Hamida Banu announced the new committee as the chief election commissioner at a press conference at Dhaka College yesterday afternoon.

Dr Banu was supported by Prof Anwarul Haque of Jagan-nath University College and former Principal of Jhalkathi College Dr Kudrat-e-Khuda as the election commissioners in conducting the polls held across the country on June 19.

A total of 3295 voters constituting 73.2 per cent of the total voters of 4500 cast votes in the election at 61 centres across the country.

This is for the first time, the executive committee of the association has been elected through direct votes.

Under the BCS Education cadre, there are around 8000 college teachers in 233 colleges, 10 teachers' training colleges and three Aleya Madrassahs.

Among the new executives, vice president Prof Khurshid Jahan, joint secretary general Fahima Khatun, organising secretary Nazim Uddin and former president of the association Prof Janab Ali were present at the press conference.
