FUBTA's concern over violence on campuses

The Federation of Bangladesh University Teachers Association (FBUTA) Thursday expressed grave concern at the spurt of violent incidents on university campuses.

The FBUTA felt that recent incidents in universities were a part of the plot to kill democracy in the country.

"Neither the ruling party nor the opposition will be benefited by these incidents," he said.

The Federation President Dr. K Mustahidur Rahman and Secretary General Dr Abdur Rahim in a press release said July 29 incident in Jahangirnagar University has come as a great shock to the entire education system. They also condemned the attack on the residence of the Vice Chancellor and offices of provosts of BUET by a section of unruly students in support of their demand for changing the examination schedule.

The federation expressed the apprehension that if the violent incidents were allowed to continue, the education system, particularly the high education, would collapse. It urged all to resist the unholy move to destroy the education system of the country.
