

Govt college teachers proposed strike put off

Bangladesh Government College Teachers Association has postponed its indefinite strike from February 13 after a meeting with the Education Minister in Dhaka on Sunday, reports UNB.

The meeting formed a high-powered committee which will submit its report on the teachers' problems to the

government in two weeks, said an official handout.

At the meeting, leaders of the association discussed with Education Minister Jamiruddin Sircar the promotion of the government college teachers, creation of posts and retrospective effect in determination of seniority.

The meeting also discussed removal of discrimination in pay-scale for 19 nationalised colleges, preparation of a combined service rule, determination of the position of the teachers in the warrant of precedence and seniority of librarians, demonstrators and physical teachers.

Additional Secretary of the Ministry Khudeza Azam, Joint Secretary Ekramullah Chowdhury, Director General of Secondary and Higher Education Prof M Eunus Mia, President of the Association Kamal Ataur Rahman, Secretary General Momtaz Begum, among others, were present at the meeting held at the Education Minister's Secretariat Office.
