JCD to check terrorism on campus

Leaders of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) on Saturday called upon all democratic student organisations to build a united movement against terrorists to bring back academic atmosphere in the educational institutions including Dhaka University.

The call was made at a rally organised by the newly formed central committee of JCD at the northern gate of arts building. The rally was addressed by JCD President Fazlul Haq Milon and General Secretary Nazimuddin Alam. It was the first formal rally of JCD after the announcement of its central committee on May 30.

They blamed Bangladesh Chhatra League (M-I) for violent activities in the educational institutions and demanded immediate arrest of the trouble-makers to bring back a cohesive

nial atmosphere.

JCD leaders said that members of JCD are determined to evict terrorism from campus and they would not allow any organisation on the campus who were giving shelter to the terrorists.

Student leaders said that some terrorists were creating trouble on Dhaka University campus through taking shelter in Jagannath Hall, the stronghold of Bangladesh Chhatra League (M-I) and urged the law enforcing agencies to take stern action against those trouble-makers.

Earlier leaders and workers of JCD brought out a procession on the campus chanting anti-terrorism slogans.
