

## Govt College teachers to begin work stoppage

Government college teachers have threatened an indefinite work stoppage from March 31 if their 16-point demand is not met by March 29, reports UNB.

In a joint statement Friday, BCS General Education Association President Principal Dr. QATM Habibur Rahman and Secretary General M Abu Yusuf urged the government to immediately implement the decisions of its meeting with the Education Ministry.

There will be no alternative for the government college teachers than to go for indefinite work stoppage from March 31 if the decisions, taken in the light of the Association's 16-point demand, are not implemented, they said.

BCS General Education Association is the professional forum of the country's government college teachers.

Besides boycotting of classes, the ensuing degree examination will come under the proposed work stoppage, the statement noted.

The leaders asked all units of the Association to complete organisational work by March 20 to make the stoppage programme a success.
