

BCL workers assault mother of admission seeker in Ctg

CHITTAGONG, Aug 9:—The supporters of Chittagong City College unit of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) assaulted the mother of an admission seeker as she refused to buy a guidebook from them on Thursday.

Aggrieved students alleged that the BCL leaders and workers of City College made buying a guidebook together with the enrolment mandatory for each entrant of the college.

and entry-examination guide. Some party insiders said that the guides, published mainly by front-liners of Bangladesh Chhatra League, were legitimate means of raising funds for political activities and hiring armed terrorists for fighting the opponents. Principal of the college admitted that a section of student leaders found it a means of personal income and accumulating funds for the party as well.

Preferring anonymity the source said that this type of business was going on in the college for decades together. None came forward to stop it.
