

||No Uttara student allowed outside during class: DMP||

DHAKA Metropolitan Police on Tuesday said that they would allow no student in school uniforms to roam outside schools in its Uttara division during their class hours.

At a press conference at DMP media centre, metropolitan police deputy commissioner (Uttara) Bidhan Tripura also said that the students roaming outside schools would be detained and taken to the respective police station.

He said that police made the decision against the backdrop of the news of enmity among the school-going teens creating groups on social media.

He said that police would hand over the detained students only to their guardians or representatives of their schools.

A youth, Adnan Kabir, 15, was killed on January 6, allegedly over rivalry among teenager gangs at Uttara over enmity between two groups - Nine Star and Disco Boys. Adnan was reportedly a member of Nine Star.

A metropolitan police Uttara division official said that they had informed the decision to the school authorities and strengthened patrol in their areas.

The Uttara division is comprised of six police stations - Uttara Model, Uttara West, Airport, Turag, Utarkhan and Dakhkhinkhan.

On February 8, Rapid Action Battalion arrested seven youths belonged to different youth gangs under different social media groups for their alleged involvement in killing Adnan at Uttara.
