No classes, exams at DU till Friday

All classes and scheduled examinations of Dhaka University have been postponed for three days from today.

Fresh dates of the examinations will be announced later and the classes will be held as usual from Saturday.

This was announced by the DU Syndicate yesterday (Monday) evening.

The Syndicate at an emergency meeting with Vice-Chancellor Prof Maniruzzaman Miah in the chair reviewed the campus situation following the violent clash between two rival student organisations on Sunday.

The meeting expressed its profound grief at the death of two students in the clash.

It condemned the attack on DUCSU office.

The Syndicate called upon the student organisations concerned to expel 'terrorists' from their
