## DU battle: None held so far

Police have not been able to arrest anybody till yesterday in connection with the October 27 gunbattle on the Dhaka University campus that left four people dead.

Two Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) workers— Galib and Liton—died on the spot in the day time battle near the Arts Faculty building of the university. Two others —Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) worker Mizan and 10-year-old street urchin Khokan—both injured in the violence, later died at Dhaka.

Medical College Hospital (DMCH).

JCD is the student wing of the ruling Bangladesh Nationalist Party (BNP) and BCL that of the opposition Awami League. JCD blamed BCL for the killings but BCL denied the charge saying that it was a sequel to in-fighting in the JCD.

The Detective Branch (DB) of Dhaka Metropolitan Police (DMP) has been continuing investigation into the incident that prompted Awami League Chief Sheikh Hasina to suspend BCL activities on the campus.

Police patrol on the campus has since been continuing though the situation there, meanwhile, returned to normal.

All classes at the university have been suspended till November 7.
