

Sangsad body to study campus violence

Parliament yesterday (Tuesday) formed a 15-member committee on campus violence, reports UNB.

The committee, proposed by Deputy Leader of the House Prof Badruddoza Chowdhury, will study pros and cons of the causes of campus violence and submit recommendation on how to overcome the situation.

It will be headed by Law and Justice Minister Mirza Golam Hafiz.

Members of the committee are: Prof Badruddoza Chowdhury, Maj Gen (Retd) Majid-ul-Huq, Abdul Matin Chowdhury, Jamir Uddin Sircar, Khandaker Delwar Hossain, Dr Khandker Mosharraf Hossain, Lt Gen (Retd) Mir Shawkat Ali, Tofael Ahmed, Mohammad Nasim, Motia

Chowdhury, Prof Abdul Mannan (AL), Dr Mizanul Haque, Rashid Khan Menon and Sheikh Ansar Ali.

The committee is composed of eight members from the Treasury Bench and seven from the Opposition.

The formation of this committee was decided by the House on August 14 following a full discussion on the campus violence. But the committee could not be formed as the opposition could not submit the names of their representatives.

Dr Badruddoza Chowdhury who proposed the committee said the names of the opposition representatives were available only on Monday.
