Polytechnique Institute and Vice-President of Chhatra League (A-A), was killed in police fire during a countrywide student strike on October 13 last year.

The rally, addressed by Momtazuddin Mehdi, Kamruzzaman Ansari and SM Kamal Hossain, vehemently condemned other student groups for not observing the day.

They called upon the student community to strengthen their struggle aimed at realisation of their 10-point demands which include repeal for all black laws, autonomy for Radio and TV and filling up of the vacant posts in government services.

The Chhatra League leaders alleged that the BNP government has shown high degree reluctance to meet the 10-point demands.

Earlier, leaders and activists of the organisation placed floral wreath at the Central Shaheed Minar and brought out a procession that paraded the Arts Faculty compound chanting slogans in favour of their demands.
