DU reopens after 47 days

A Sun Report

The Dhaka University reopened yesterday (Tuesday) after 47 days of unscheduled closure. The University was closed since the gunbattle between the activists of Bangladesh Chhatra League and Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal, students wing respectively of Awami League and ruling Bangladesh Nationalist Party (BNP), on July 30. Slogans, often provocative, were again heard on the campus though the attendance in the classes was thin.

A negligible number of students returned to residential halls, reopened a day earlier.

Despite all rhetorics, there had been no arrangement for authenticating the identities of the returnees and, hence, the "trouble-

makers" had no difficulties in entering the halls.

A contingent of police were seen guarding the resident of the Vice Chancellor and a few other members of the law enforcing agencies, all in plain clothes, were keeping their eyes on the situation.
