

DU authorities urge political parties

Don't make campus a battle ground

Dhaka University authorities yesterday (Monday) expressed grave concern over the deteriorating law and order situation on the Campus and said that a good number of arms and ammunition were brought into residential halls.

An emergency meeting of the provosts, house tutors, proctor and assistant proctors with Vice-Chancellor Prof. M Maniruzzaman Miah in the chair yesterday reviewed the overall campus situation.

The meeting felt that the Campus situation has become volatile and none felt secured with the presence of armed outsiders in

the halls. The meeting regretted that different political parties through their student wings were trying to establish their sphere of influence on the campus. It said since the problem was a political one, its solution also lies with the political parties.

The meeting called upon the political parties not to make the campus a battle field. In a resolution the meeting called upon the law enforcing agencies to recover all arms from the residential halls and arrest the outsiders.

The hall administration have reportedly taken some measures for immediate implementation.
