

Student found dead at Sylhet college hostel

POLICE recovered the body of a student from a hostel of Sylhet Government Women's College on Sunday night.

The deceased was identified as Subi Begum, 20, a first year student of economics department and daughter of Bashar Ali of village Shridhar-pasha under Jagannathpur in Sunamganj, police said.

'Subi along with her four roommates had been living at the hostel's room no 210 for around a year; her roommates left the hostel few days ago for Ramadan vacation. Some of her classmates informed the hostel authorities around 8:00pm on Sunday as they did not get any response even after repeated knock on the door,' the college hostel superintendent, Jamalur Rahman, said.

Kotwali police recovered the body of Subi which was hanging from the ceiling fan of the room around 11:00pm, the hostel super added.

Kotwali police officer-in-charge Sohel Ahmad confirmed the news of recovering the body.

The body was handed over to Subi's family on Monday afternoon after completion of postmortem examinations at the Sylhet Osmani Medical College Hospital, the OC said.
