BAU students demonstrate in front of VC residence

Students of Bangladesh Agricultural University on Monday demonstrated in front of the vice-chancellor's residence demanding their nine points including increasing number of ambulance, upgrading the health care centre service, resignation of the dean of veterinary science faculty, among others.

Sources said a second-year foreign student of the veterinary science faculty Harani Janaki Raman died at Mymensingh Medical College Hospital from asphyxia recently.

Students of the university claimed that the health care centre authority did not take special care and the ambulance was also not available at that time.

The students complained to the vice-chancellor that the veterinary science faculty dean was not student-friendly and also harassed them.

While keeping anonymity, some of the teachers said many of the students were outraged at the dean because of his disciplinary action against some students for behaving insolently with the teachers.

They pressured the dean in various ways to withdraw the punishment. As a result, the students started the movement. Dean of veterinary science faculty Nazim Ahmed said he does not know why the students demonstrated for his resignation and assumed it might be for punishing the students.
