

DU admission seeker handed over to police for forgery *General students demand retake of 'D' unit test*

THE Dhaka University authorities on Saturday handed over an admission seeker to Shahbagh Police Station on charge of fraudulence in admission test.

Aoun Kumar Das, who stood 3rd in the admission test for the 'D' unit (commerce) under the 2016-17 academic session, could not pass a viva-voce held afresh in the morning after suspicion arose.

He secured only five out of 30 marks in Bangla, the lone subject in which the examination was arranged.

Earlier, Aoun secured 27 out of 30 in Bangla during the test of 'D' unit.

The move of fresh test came following allegations of forgery.

The university vice-chancellor, AAMS Arefin Siddique, said, 'We already handed over an admission seeker to police on suspicion of forgery.'

He also warned that steps would be taken against those who did forgery during the admission tests.
