

JU BCL demands execution of HC verdict on Tarique

LEADERS and activists of Jahangirnagar University unit of Bangladesh Chhatra League on Friday staged demonstration and held rally on the campus, demanding immediate execution of the sentence to BNP senior vice-chairman Tarique Rahman by the High Court.

Around 500 BCL activists brought out a protest procession, led by JU BCL president Mahmudur Rahman Jony, from JU transport premises around 11:30am that ended at the main entrance after parading various avenues on the campus, followed by short a rally.

Mahmudur Rahman said, 'Tarique Rahman was patronising militant and terrorist activities carried out across the country.

'We urged the government to implement the HC verdict by repatriating him into the country as early as possible,' Jony added.

BCL leaders Ariful Islam Arif, Mithun Kumar Kundu, Istiaque Ahmed and Toni Kundu, among others, also addressed the rally.

Earlier, Tarique Rahman was sentenced to seven years' imprisonment and fined Tk 20 crore by the High Court on Thursday in a money laundering case.
