

Corrected result cannot restore SSC candidate to life

SSC candidate Sarbajit Ghosh Ridoy who committed suicide on Wednesday after getting failed mark in religion subject finally got A plus in the corrected result published on Saturday in Barisal.

Family members said that education board was responsible for publishing wrong result that took away the life of the meritorious youth.

Sarbajit Ghosh Ridoy who took part in the SSC examination in science group from the Udayan Secondary School in Barisal this year was found unsuccessful in the result published on Wednesday.

Sarbajit, son of Shekhar Ghosh, a businessman at city's Curpotti road, committed suicide jumping from a multi-storey building getting the result.

On Saturday, Barisal education board published the corrected result of 4.68 (A-plus) that was conveyed to his mother Shila Ghosh who became senseless hearing the result.

Not only Sarbajit, a total of 1,141 candidates got passed marks in Hindu religion subject after re-assessed examination under Barisal board. Of them 79 candidates got GPA-5.

Besides, results of 5809 candidates were promoted to passed marks after re-assessment.

Education board chairman Mohammad Ziaul Haque said that such situation was created due to lack of knowledge of two chief controllers. A probe committee has already been formed in this regard.

Action will be taken against them as per rules, he said.

About suicide of the candidate, the board chairman said that it was sad and he also felt shocked at the incidence.
