

HSC exams for May 27 deferred to June 12

THE Higher Secondary Certificate exams scheduled for May 27 have been deferred to June 12 due to the fifth phase of union parishad polls, officials have said.

Voters of over 720 UPs across the country will cast their votes to elect their representatives on May 28.

Election Commission normally sends voting materials to the polling centres on the previous day of election, and in most cases polling takes place at school and college buildings.

Following a request from

the Election Commission, we deferred the exams from May 27 to June 12' the inter education board coordination sub-committee chairman Mahbubur Rahman said.

With the changes, second paper exams of economics and commercial geography will begin at 10:00am, while the exams for Islamic history and culture and chemistry second paper will be at 2:00pm, on June 12.

These exams were actually scheduled for May 22, and were deferred to May 27 due to cyclone 'Roanu' on May 21, officials said.
