Security tightened at RU

SECURITY measures were beefed up at Rajshahi University campus on Friday.

Additional uniformed police and plainclothes detectives have been deployed at various points across the campus and that several check posts have been set up.

Campus sources said a circular issued by RU registrar professor Muhammad Entazul Huque on 16 July urged all the faculty mem-

bers, students, and staff of the university to keep their university identity cards with them for the sake of their security.

The heightened security followed similar moves taken at airports and power plants of the country in the wake of extremists' attacks at a cafe in Dhaka and Sholakia police post in Kishoreganj.

On Friday, this correspondent saw students and faculty members were entering in the university after showing their varsity iden-

tity cards. Every vehicle was searched.

The officer-in-charge of Motihar police, Humayun Kabir, told New Age that they tightened security measures in Rajshahi metropolitan city and on the university campus to ward off any untoward incidents.

RU proctor professor Mujibul Hauqe Azad Khan said the police asked the RU authority to help the law enforcers strengthen security on the campus.
