Class III boy caned by teacher in Sylhet

A FEMALE teacher caned rampantly a class three student in Sylhet on Monday that left 36 marks on his back, though corporal punishment is banned in the educational institutions.

The victim, Sayeem Ahmad Bijoy, 9, is a class three student of Mohammadpur Government Primary School at Silam union under Dakkhin Surma in the district and son of Shamim Ahmad of Mohammadpur village in the same area.

Bijoy's father alleged that Mita Rani Gosh, an assistant teacher of the primary school, beat Bijoy mercilessly on Monday afternoon on charge of not taking the book of homework in the classroom.

'Several teachers of the school visited my house on Monday evening and requested me not to inform the incident to any one,' Bijoy's father told on Tuesday afternoon.

Mohammadpur Government Primary School's headmaster Sirajul Islam admitted New Age of the incident and said he was trying to resolve the matter through discussion with the guardians of the student.

The district primary education officer Nurul Islam told that he was not aware of such incident.
