## 1512 SSC examinees expelled in 2 days

**COMILLA**, Mar 21: With the expulsion of 493 SSC examinees on the second day of the examination, the total number of expelled examinees stood at 949 till Sunday according to the Controller of Examinations, Comilla Board.

On the first day, a total of 456 examinees from 30 centres of five districts were expelled. The districts are: Comilla, Chandpur, Brahmanbaria, Syhet and Noakhali.

On the second day, expulsion was done in 26 centres of Comilla, Chandpur, Brahmanbaria, Chittagong and Noakhali.

Eight teachers have also been expelled from four centres in two days while 63 copy suppliers were taken into custody.

So far, 439 examinees have been expelled in Comilla district alone, the sources said.

### JAMALPUR

Our Correspondent from Jamalpur reports: Eightythree examinees were expelled from different centres of the district. Besides, one person was arrested for supplying copy to the examinees.

### RAJBARI

Our Rajbari Correspondent says: The police resorted to lathicharge and 13 rounds of blank fire to control the situation at the SSC Examination centre at Sher-e-Bangla High School in Rajbari district head quarters on Saturday.

Two policemen and one irregular examinee were injured and 17 answer scripts missing due to disturbances.

Similar situation was also created at the Zila High School

centre when the magistrate took stern attitude to adopting unfair means by examinees. The examinees with the supports of the out siders ransacked the examination halls and broke chairs, benches and window panes.

Five persons were arrested in this connection.

### NEW TECHNIC OF ADOPTING UNFAIR MEANS

Our Sailkupa Correspondent says: A new technic of adopting unfair means in the SSC examination has been unearthed at Sailkupa centre on Saturday night.

It is learnt that some 23 answer scripts written outside the hall by outsiders were detected by the Upazila Magistrate. The answer scripts were being packed for sending to Jessore Board.

It is learnt that earlier the original answer scripts were taken out in connivance with a section of teachers entrusted with the responsibility of conducting the examination.

### RANGPUR

BSS adds: A total of 204 SSC examinees were expelled in the first two days of the examination for adopting unfair means in seven centres of Rangpur district.

A total of 8,149 examinees are appearing in the examination from eight centres.

No examinees were expelled from Badarganj centre.

In Kushtia, 153 examinees were expelled on the second day from 16 centres.

On the first day, 123 examinees were expelled for adopting unfair means.
