2807 expelled on first day of HSC exams

A total of 2807 candidates were expelled on the first day of the Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) examinations under the four education boards yesterday.

Besides, one invigilator and a hall superintendent were expelled at Noapara centre and at Belabo centre in Narsingdi on charge of supplying copies.

Two policemen were injured in brick-throwing by the outsiders at Daudkandi centre under the Comilla Board. Police opened fire to disperse the outsiders at three centres under the Dhaka and Comilla

boards. Nobody was, however, injured in the firing.

Huge copies were recovered from the examinees and also from an outsider at a centre in Pabna district under the Rajshahi Board.

This year a total of 3,22,993 examinees are appearing in the HSC examinations at 511 centres under the four education boards.

A total of 130 students of Mohanpur upazila centre under the Rajshahi Board could not appear in yesterday's examinations as the board authorities declared them as illegitimate candidates.
