Fresh explosion hikes tension on DU campus

The tense situation on the Dhaka University continued yesterday with unidentified elements exploding a bomb and manhandling a youngman at Mohsin Hall.

The bomb was blasted at about 12.30 pm in the hall premises. None was injured in the explosion. At about 3 pm a youngman was manhandled at the guest room of the hall. His identity could not be known.

While contacted, Dr SMA Fayed, Provost of the hall, said the youngman was an outsider.

Over the last one week, several workers of both the Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dai (JCD)

and chhatra league (H.A) were stabbed and manhandled in clashes between the two groups besides, a number of rooms of different residential halls were ransacked and the inmates of the rooms were ousted.

The trouble followed clashes between the workers of JED and CI (H-A) at Dhaka College on Monday last. The college was closed later.

Vice-Chancellor of Dhaka University Prof Abdul Mannan yesterday lauded the students of Fazlul Huq Hall of the university for what he said setting an example of peaceful co-exi-
