

/GULSHAN ATTACK \\ JU hails role of ex-students Robiul, Ahad

Teachers and students of Jahangirnagar University yesterday held a meeting for two police officers, also its alumni, recalling their commendable roles during the July 1 Gulshan cafe siege.

Assistant Commissioner of Detective Branch of Dhaka Metropolitan Police Robiul Karim, who graduated in Bangla, was killed, and Additional Deputy Commissioner of DMP Abdul Ahad, an ex-student of government and politics, was injured, while on a rescue operation for the hostages.
