

135 Pry. teachers not getting salary for three months

KURIGRAM, Dec. 4.—For administrative bottleneck 135 Primary school teachers of Fulbari upazila under Kurigram district are not getting salary for the last three months, it is alleged.

Allegation have it that the said 135 teachers according to an earlier official order were getting usual salaries including 2 extra increments as Mujib Nagar employees. But the Rangpur Regional Accounts officer issued orders for stoppage of their salary and extra increments. The D.G. Primary Education, Dhaka by an order made it clear that Mujib Nagar employees were getting two extra increments would be getting the same as usual. But the Rangpur Regional Accounts officer again

stopped the payment of extra increments and salary of the teachers. The D.G. Primary Education again directed the Regional Accounts Officer, Rangpur for passing the bills. the Bhurungamari Upazila Accounts office in accordance to the same Memo passed the bills of teachers of Bhurungamari upazila.

But, the Fulbari Upazila Accounts officer is not passing the bills and as such the Mujib Nagar employees are not getting salaries for the last three months.

They are passing days in great hardship. The teachers urged upon the concerned authorities to see into the matter at an early date and take proper steps in this regard.
