Ranisankail primary schools in doldrums

THAKURGAON, Jan. 30:—The primary schools throughout Ranisankail Upazila of Thakurgaon district have been facing multifarious problems which included accommodation, shortage of furniture, drinking water, urinals and teachers.

There are 55 Govt. primary schools and 7 non-Govt. primary schools in Ranisankail. Most of the non-Govt. primary schools had been established with the local initiative but they did not get the government recognition.

The institutions have a good number of students. Being disappointed the teachers of those schools have been compelled to leave the schools.

On the other hand, due to shortage of furniture in most of the

schools, the students sit on mats. Many schools have inadequate accommodation and students sit under the open sky.

The prizes were distributed among the winners in the annual sports and best students for their brilliant results in the examination at a function held in Vandara Govt. Primary School under Ranisankail upazila on January 23.

The function was presided over by Mr. Golam Rasul, President of the Managing Committee. The upazila level officers and parents of the students also attended the function. Nehar Moni, Mashuma Akhtar Lipi and Sultana Parveen Beauty have been awarded for their brilliant results in the examination.
