



## Medical education under autonomous varsity soon

Medical education in the country will soon be brought under an autonomous university. A policy decision has been taken in this regard for rapid implementation, reports BSS.

This was disclosed by the Deputy Prime Minister in charge of the Ministry of Home Affairs Prof. M.A. Matin on Friday while addressing as the chief guest at the oath taking and installation ceremony of Bangladesh Private Medical Practitioners Association at BCPS (Bangladesh College of Physicians and Surgeons) auditorium an official press release said.

Prof Matin said an ordinance

was very much in the offing from the relevant ministry about autonomy to medical education.
