

CU golden jubilee celebrations start tomorrow

Chittagong University (CU) will begin its two-day golden jubilee celebrations from tomorrow with 29,901 former and current students registering to take part.

A procession will be brought out from the fine arts institute and a discussion organised later at Chittagong city's GEC Convention Centre followed by a cultural programme where Rina Laila is to appear.

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina is scheduled to inaugurate over telephone the second day's programmes at the CU central playground while Jatiya Sangsad Speaker Shirin Shafmin Chaudhury will be present as the chief guest.

Prof Emeritus Anisuzzaman, a former faculty member, will deliver a memorial speech and another discussion will be held.

Performances by incumbent students, eminent singers Dinat Jahan Munni and Tapan Chowdhury and bands Artcell, Warfaze and Lalor will mark the end of programmes.
