

Atiur returns to DU

ATIUR Rahman returned to teaching at department of development studies at Dhaka University on Wednesday, a day after he resigned as the Bangladesh Bank governor.

Atiur resigned on Tuesday amidst criticism about the theft of \$101 million of Bangladesh's reserve with the Federal Reserve Bank of New York and for not informing the finance ministry.

Chairman of the department Mohammad Abu Eusuf confirmed Atiur's joining.

He joined the department on Wednesday morning as a professor, he said.

Atiur was at deputation from 2009.
