

66 pry schools to be built in nine southern districts

JESSORE, Oct. 1 The Facilities Department under the Ministry of Education will construct 66 primary school buildings in 9 southern districts of Khulna division during the current financial year at a total cost of Taka 2 crore 18 lakh under Mass Education Programme. All these school buildings will be completed soon.

In Jessore district 14 school buildings will be constructed.

Three school buildings will be constructed, one each at Narail Sadar, Lobagara and Kalia upazila. In Magura district 4 school buildings will be constructed, 2 in Sadar and 1 each at Sreepur, Salikha and Mohammadpur upazilas. Two such buildings will be constructed 1 each at Shailakupa and Kotchandpur upazila under Jhenidah district.

In Khulna district, 1 each at Daulatpur, Koira, Paikgachha, Terokhada, Rupsa, Phultala, Dakope, Battaghaha and 3 in Dumuria upazila will be constructed.

BARISAL

BSS adds: The Facilities Department of the Ministry of Education will implement eleven education projects under Universal Primary Education programme at a cost of Tk. 10,79,430 during the current fiscal 1987-88.

Official sources said, Barisal, Madaripur, Shariatpur, Pirojpur and Barguna districts have been

taken under the programme in Barisal education zone of Khulna division.

Of the total one project will be implemented in Barisal, two in Madaripur, one in Shariatpur, six in Pirojpur and one in Barguna districts.

A semi-pucca type office building will be constructed at each of the eleven government primary schools.

Each of the projects will cost Tk. 98,130 and the work is expected to be completed within the next four months.
