



Tk 1.57 crore for construction of 40 primary schools

MYMENSINGH, Oct. 18: The construction work of nine primary schools have been completed with a total cost of Taka 25.20 lakh during the current financial year under Integrated School Development Programme.

The construction work of 24 more primary schools is going on in full swing and will be completed by December. The construction work of another 7 primary schools is yet to start.

It is learnt that Taka 1.57 crore was sanctioned under Integrated School Development Programme for the construc-

tion of 40 primary schools in five upazilas of Mymensingh district during the last financial year.

The repair work of eight primary school have been completed with a total cost of Taka 6.9 lakh.

It is further learnt that Taka 21 lakh was sanctioned under development programme for the major repair of 20 primary schools and minor repair of another 20 schools during the last financial year.

HOUSEWIFE KILLED

One Panbanu Nesa, 50, wife of Mamtaz Uddin of village Talab under Bhaluka upazila was killed in a clash between two groups over damage standing paddy crops by cattle heads recently.

It is learnt that while Panbanu Nesa tried to drive away the cattlehead from her paddy field a group of people attacked her with lathi and she died later on at the Bhaluka Hospital.
