Primary education in jeopardy

RANGPUR, June 30:—The primary schools in Aditmari Upazila are in deplorable condition. As a result, thousands of students studying in these schools are facing untold sufferings. Many schools have no fencing while buildings of many others are in dilapidated condition.

The number of benches, black boards and furniture is adequate but the academic students have to sit on the Kutcha floor of these schools for want of benches.

In many schools the classes are held under the tree within the school compound for want of sitting accommodation in the class rooms. During the rainy season, most of these schools are remained closed as the rain waters trickle through cracks of the roofs.
