

Situation at Barisal Medical College tense

BARISAL, July 27:—A tense situation has been prevailing in Barisal Medical College Hospital following a conflict that occurred between Internee doctors and Class IV employees of the hospital.

The reason of the conflict is that one driver of the hospital was allegedly beaten by one Internee doctor Shahnewaz Biplob recently regarding treatment of a patient in the hospital.

After the incident the Class IV employees of the hospital have been holding rallies and bringing out processions on Barisal Medical College Hospital and College campus's everyday demanding punishment and cancellation of registration of Dr. Biplob. On the other hand, all Internee doctors of the hospital have been observing three-hour token-strike everyday protesting against misbehaviour of some employees with Dr. Biplob.

Police have been deployed in the hospital to avert any clash between Internee doctors and Class IV employees there.
