

Irregularity in Rajbari primary school alleged

RAJBARI, Sept. 19: Bariajuri Primary School of Panghsa thana has been a matter of common criticism among the people due to serious irregularity in attendance both of the teaching staff and the students.

Almost all the teachers come from the same locality and near the school premises. They treat the school as their drawing room for which neither they need pay attention towards their honest duty nor the taughts care much of them. As a result, standard of teaching has been greatly degraded. For example, the students of Class IV and V have not been taught even ABC of arithmetic nor they can read out their Bengali text book. More funny is that the students of Class II cannot recognise the Bengali alphabets. Over and above, the matter which has dissatisfied the local guardians is that, most of the teachers have deeply indulged themselves in local politics and have made it a regular fashion of making produ adventure to the mofussil court on different useless village litigations; the people expect good conscience of responsibility from the authority concerned.

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
