

Primary exam in Narsingdi under private initiative

NARSINGDI, Sept. 8: Primary final examination will be held in five police stations of this subdivision under private initiative this year, it is learnt. Official sources told Times that a good result was achieved in the development of primary education at Narsingdi and Rajshahi police stations where primary final examination system was introduced last year under private initiative.

A meeting of the leading teachers and all the Thana Education Officers of the subdivision was held recently at the Narsingdi Thana Education Office for taking necessary steps for the introduction of primary final examination in all thanas of the subdivision.

Schools Dacca and the Sub-divisional Education Officer, Narsingdi also attended the meeting as distinguished guests. The meeting resolved to take primary final examination in all the thanas on compulsory basis this year.

A Subdivisional Primary Final Examination Co-ordination Committee was also formed with Mr. Nurul Hoque Secretary of the Bangladesh Primary Teachers Association (BPTA) and SDEO Narsingdi as Secretary and President respectively.

The District Inspector of Schools Dacca disclosed that primary final examination would be held in all the subdivisions of Dacca district under private initiative this year.
