Islamic University master's students to leave halls within 15 days after exams

Islamic University authorities in Kushtia on Sunday announced that the master's degree students must leave their halls within 15 days after the end of their final examinations.

A press release, signed by IU acting registrar Parvez Miah, was issued in this regard in the evening.

According to the release, the decision was made to take control over the university halls through the provosts.

Chaired by IU vice-chancellor M Harun-Ur-Rashid, an emergency meeting of the university's hall provosts was held on Saturday.

The university authorities also formed a monitoring cell, led by proctor Paresh Chandra Barman, to monitor the halls so that no students face persecution and torture by any group or leaders of any student bodies.

IU vice-chancellor told New Age that stern actions would be taken if any students were found involvement with harassing other students of the university.
