BCL faction locks up Islamic University entrance demanding case withdrawal

A faction of Bangladesh Chhatra League's Islamic University unit on Monday locked up the university's main entrance demanding withdrawal of a case filed against one of their fellows.

The faction also demanded cancellation of Mahbubar Rahman's membership in the university syndicate.

The faction leader Jubayer Rahman brought out and led the protest procession of about a hundred Chhatra League activists at about 1:50pm. The activists locked up the university's main entrance at 2:00pm and kept it so until 2:30pm pushing for their demands.

Mahbubar Rahman, also university's former proctor, filed a defamation case against the university Chhatra League's former education affairs secretary Mizanur Rahman on October 17 for allegedly accusing Mahbubar of involvement in recruitment scam during his tenure as a proctor.

Mahbubar –who resigned from the post of proctor on September 22 following a protest demanding his removal on September 21– denied the allegations. He also said if anybody could prove the allegations against him true, he would leave the campus.
