BUET classes to resume from Nov 26

The under-graduate classes of Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology (BUET) will resume from November 26 (Saturday) next. The residential halls will reopen on Friday.

The university was closed on October 26 following the boycott of classes by the students for two consecutive weeks in support of their two demands which include abolition of class tests and enhancement of the amount of scholarship money.

However, a leader of Students Action Council, an alliance of eight prominent students organisations of BUET, told this correspondent that they would continue their movement until the two demands were not met.
