BUET relaxes exam rules

The authorities of Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology (BUET) on Monday relaxed some existing rules and adopted few new ones relating to the class test to make them reasonable and acceptable to students, university sources said.

The BUET authorities directed the different departmental heads to be responsible for the class test and urged the students to attend their classes immediately.

Earlier, a committee was formed on class test comprising departmental heads and senior Professors where the students can bring them complaints about any

problem.

They said that the authorities were well aware of the need for the enhancement of stipends but the class test would never be cancelled.

The students, however, continued their strike to press home their two point charter of demands when the university reopened on Saturday after one month's unscheduled closure.

The BUET was closed since then by the authorities on October 26 following a two-week class boycott by the students on the issue of abolition of class test and the enhancement of stipends.
