Mentioning that university is a place of knowledge production, Professor Zoynal Abedin said, 'Library is the repository of that knowledge.'

The library shows the path of light to the young generation in the fields of science and technology, cultural practice and development of consciousness and values to build a society and a country free from discrimination, he added.

He noted that all necessary measures had already been taken to enrich the central library of DUET by providing up-to-date and modern reading materials.


Unveiling two albums for the Liberation War Corner and the Victory 2024 Corner, he expressed hope that the albums would play an important role in informing future generations about the history of the Liberation War and the July uprising and in promoting the excellence of science and technology.

He also inaugurated the  **books** issue service through Koha ILS software, expressing hope that this step would play a leading role in making the library's resource management, cataloguing, book exchange and report preparation work easier and more dynamic.
