HSC exams routine published

The Higher Secondary Certificate examinations will start from July 2.

The Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education, Dhaka on Wednesday published the routine for nine general boards—Dhaka, Rajshahi, Jashore, Cumilla, Chattogram, Barishal, Sylhet, Dinajpur and Mymensingh.



As per the routine, the theoretical part of the examinations will be held between July 2 and August 8 and the practical part will be held by August 15.

According to the routine, the morning examinations will be held between 10:00am and 1:00pm and the afternoon examinations will be held between 2:00pm and 5:00pm.

Bangladesh Madrassah Education Board and Bangladesh Technical Education Board, however, have not published the routines yet for the Alim and vocational examinations respectively.

Before the Covid-19 pandemic had hit the country in 2020, every year the HSC and equivalent exams used to start in the first week of April.

In 2020, Secondary School Certificate and equivalent examinations were held as usual, while the HSC and equivalent examinees were awarded grade points using the subject-mapping method.

For the pandemic, in 2024, 2023, 2022 and 2021 the HSC examinations took place in June, in August, in November and in December respectively.

This year decision was taken initially to start the exams in June, but later the government took decision to start the exams from July.

The HSC examinations' routine published on Wednesday mentioned that the engineering drawing and workshop practice (1st paper) examinations would be held at the examinees' own colleges with the respective principals to oversee the examinations after collecting question papers from the main centre at 9:00am.

The numbers obtained in practical examinations would be entered online or submitted following the directives of the controllers of examinations in each board by August 15, it also said.

In the routine, 11 special instructions have been given that include the following: no one, except for the exam secretary, will be allowed to carry mobile phones to the examination centres; the examinations will be held in the time mentioned in the question paper and at first the multiple choice questions part of the examinations will be held followed by the essay, theoretical, part of the examinations without any gap; all examinees have been requested to enter their respective examination halls 30 minutes before the starting time, use only basic scientific calculators (non-programmed); the candidates to pass SSC exams will have to pass the multiple choices, the theoretical and the practical parts of the examinations separately.
