34,054 absent on 3rd day of SSC, equivalent exams

A total of 34,054 examinees were absent on Sunday, the third day of the ongoing Secondary School Certificate and its equivalent examinations.

On the day, 40 candidates were also expelled from the examinations.



The SSC and equivalent examinations began on April 21.

On the third day, examinations were held on English (compulsory) first paper subject under the nine general boards, mathematics subject under the madrassah education board, and mathematics (2) subject under the technical education board.

Across nine general boards 15,599 examinees (1.29 per cent) were absent out of 12,08,346 candidates, and 21 examinees were expelled on the third day.

Under Bangladesh Madrassah Board 14,963 examinees (5.29 per cent) were absent out of total 2,83,072 candidates, and 15 examinees were expelled.

Under the Bangladesh Technical Education Board 3,492 examinees (2.78 per cent) out of total 1,25,581 candidates were absent, and four examinees were expelled on the third day of the examinations.

This year, around 18.57 lakh examinees from 30,666 educational institutions are scheduled to sit for the exams at 3,885 centres. In 2025, around 19.28 lakh candidates took the examinations.

On the first and second days of the examinations, 25,408 and 26,865 were absent respectively.
