# Convicted ex-BRUR VC sent to jail

Former vice-chancellor of Begum Rokeya University, Rangpur, Md Hasibur Rashid, who was convicted in the Abu Sayed killing case, was sent to jail by the International Crimes Tribunal-2 yesterday.

The tribunal passed the order after he was produced before it.

Earlier, the tribunal sentenced Hasibur Rashid to 10 years' imprisonment on charges of command responsibility in the killing of Abu Sayed.

Police arrested Hasibur Rashid from a relative's house on Shaheed Salim Ullah Road in Mohammadpur around 8:30pm Saturday.

Abu Sayed, a student of BRUR was killed in police firing during the July uprising.
