JU tops Bangladesh in chemistry research ranking

Jahangirnagar University has ranked first among Bangladeshi universities and research institutions in chemistry in the latest Nature Index Ranking, highlighting its growing footprint in global scientific research.

The ranking was based on research papers published between February 2025 and January 2026 in 145 leading international journals covering natural and health sciences.



According to the index, the chemistry department secured the country's top position in the discipline, reflecting its contribution to internationally recognised research and academic collaboration.

Vice-chancellor professor Mohammad Kamrul Ahsan congratulated the department's teachers, researchers and students, saying the achievement stemmed from sustained dedication to maintaining global research standards.

'This recognition reflects the quality of research conducted at the university and our expanding presence in the international academic arena,' he said in a statement.

He also said that the latest results underscored the university's ongoing efforts to strengthen research capacity and boost visibility in global scientific publications.

Beyond Chemistry, JU ranked 11th nationally in Earth and Environmental Sciences, 16th in Biological Sciences and 18th in Health Sciences.
