Schools, technical instts to resume classes tomorrow

All government and non-government primary and secondary level schools, as well as technical and vocational institutions nationwide, will resume academic activities tomorrow following the combined Eid-ul-Azha and summer vacation.

After around two weeks, thousands of students will return to the classrooms.



Though the scheduled holiday ended on Thursday, due to two consecutive weekly holidays on Friday and Saturday, the institutions will reopen tomorrow.

Meanwhile, the madrassahs will reopen on June 12.

Eid-ul-Azha was celebrated on May 28 and the government announced a seven-day holiday from May 25 to 31.

The government primary schools went to vacation from May 24 till June 4, as per the academic calendar issued by the primary and mass education ministry.

As per the academic calendar issued by the Secondary and Higher Education Division under the education ministry, the holiday in government and non-government secondary and junior secondary level educational institutions started on May 24 and continued till June 4.

The academic calendar issued by the Technical and Madrasah Education Division for the technical and vocational institutions under the Bangladesh Technical Education Board, these institutions went to vacation on May 24 which also continued till June 4.

In cases of the madrassahs, the academic calendar issued by the Technical and Madrasah Education Division, the holiday started from May 24 which will continue till June 11.

The public universities will be reopened on their own schedules, while the National University has already reopened on June 2.
